



Job Description for the Dance Worker

Job Title: Dance Worker (Temporary position)
Responsible to: Dance Development Manager

Job Outline:

The candidate should have a minimum of three years practical experience of teaching dance with disabled and non-disabled people and be educated HND level or equivalent.

The post holder will work 16hrs a week over a variety of classes

Length of employment is for 12 weeks on a temporary contract which may be extended.

Salary £18,525 (pro rata) Rate of £9.50ph

Main Purpose:

The post will be

-Delivering dance workshops to disabled and non disabled people including children, young people and adults over a weekly programme.

-Working holidays with outreach classes/residencies as required.

-Work in education establishments and longer projects.

-In addition, the dance worker will work alongside the dance development worker/dance development Manager to deliver projects to providers /schools /information days and outreach clubs.

The Dance Worker is responsible to the Dance Development Manager for the development and implementation of this programme of activities.

Desirable Skills:

- Full Driving License.
- Knowledge and understanding of Award in Dance Leadership
- Ability to represent Indepen-dance in a wide range of contexts, from local schools to national agencies.



Person specification:

- Have a qualification in dance at HND or above
- Have a good contemporary dance technique and strong in popular dance trends
- Be Reliable
- Have experience of working creatively with disabled children, young people and adults in a range of contexts
- Be able to inspire and enthuse participants to actively engage in dance sessions

Main duties of Dance Worker

- Developing and leading dance workshops with disabled people of all ages (eg children, youths and adults), as directed by the Dance Development Manager which may include evening and weekends.
- Develop and maintain positive links with partnership agencies and organisation's in the local area of work when delivering outreach work.
- Establishing and maintaining high standards of dance tuition in keeping with the established quality of Indepen-dance's work in all class settings.
- Contributing and supporting the administration and evaluation of projects with the Creative Team.
- Ensuring that sound customer care practices are operated.
- Assisting with the implementation of approved systems and procedures for all dance classes/workshops, including booking forms, registers/ new members at classes and feeding back attendance, issues at classes to the relevant team member.
- working closely with the office to feedback any information.
- To promote and develop our education work with schools alongside the dance development worker
- To deliver and maintain the standards of Indepen-dance classes and ethos.
