Waste, Energy, Logistics & Food

- Reduce freight and energy useage by making use of technical equipment and stock at partner venue.
- Offer local sustainable food suggestions and options, such as the Gurdwara and providers on Albert Drive.
- Encourage all participants, staff & volunteers to bring their own water bottles and coffee cups to be used at refill stations, to avoid plastic waste.
- Waste separation is available. Although this is managed by the partner venue, we would encourage all to follow their guidance.
- There will be no festival merchandise so as to reduce use of one time use products.
- Our Company productions all include re-used and re-purposed costumes.

Programme

- Our Company productions have performed at various other events, and will continue to perform throughout the rest of the year.

Travel & Mobility

- Making our partner venue in a location near good public transport links, such as bus and trains, to avoid car travel.
- Book our international guests as close to the partner venue as possible so as to reduce travel emissions.
