Flux and Flourish was reviewed as a 'Highly Recommend Show'. A new work featuring our staff and members, the performance featured choreography from key moments of notable performances across the years.

One of our members; Iona, who performed as part of the group said: "Dance means that I can be free. My overall hope as a dancer is to show that although I am a wheelchair user I am not restricted to it, I'm not stuck to my wheelchair" Iona also took part in creating work and performed a work in progress; "This festival is really important to me to be able to connect with people all over the world, this week I am creating work with LPM (England) and ConCuerpos (Colombia) and performing".

We would like to say a thank you to all of our funders and our supporters who donate to us through our Friends of Indepen-dance scheme who help make this event possible.

Our chair of the Board Mairi Breckenridge opened the festival by highlighting the importance of funding for the arts; "The current economic situation seems likely to lead to significant cuts in public spending, with both the health and social care and arts sectors likely to be affected. This will have an impact on many of those individuals who come to Indepen-dance. We know that cuts in the social care budget put huge pressure on individuals and families but are also clear that involvement in any form of art or cultural activity is not just an add on but something that significantly enhances the quality of life of individuals and of the community."
